THE CAUSE: This Thanksgiving we need your help providing 200 Thanksgiving meals to struggling families in Cobb & Paulding counties.

The best way to do this is for people like you to commit to purchasing the needed items to provide one or more full meals. ALL OF THE TURKEYS WILL BE TAKEN CARE OF, but we need you to help with the rest of the supplies for these meals. To keep it easy, we have put a supply list below. If you will purchase the meal, we will make sure it gets to a family in need. (Go to www.EaglePointe.org to give online. Select "Give the Bird")

We will put together & deliver these meals on Saturday Nov. 22nd. You can drop off complete meals to Eagle Pointe Church any time between today and Friday November 20th. We will certainly accept bulk quantities of different items, but ideally we need people to bring complete meals in a bag. This helps avoid 400 cans of one item & not enough of another.

Below you will find the items needed to provide a complete Thanksgiving meal to a family in need:

2 boxes of Cornbread mix

1 box Mac-n-Cheese

1 can of cranberry sauce

1 box of stuffing

1 can of green beans

1 can of corn

1 box/package of Instant mashed potatoes

1 packet or can of gravy

1 can of Yams

1 unfrozen dessert item

Please bring all items listed above to Eagle Pointe Church no later than Friday 11-20-15.
